Thomas & Ellen Kelly Brennan Family Remembering James Brennan

James Brennan, the eldest son of Thomas and Ellen, born in 1902, immigrated to America in 1927 and married Margaret (Peg) Melody Brennan in 1931. A devoted and hardworking man, James was known for his faith, loyalty, and dedication to family.

During World War II, he contributed to the war effort as a security guard at the Brooklyn and Jersey City Navy Yards (see photo on page 1), often working long hours to keep both facilities safe. After the war, he co-owned a local bar and grill and cherished spending weekends with his sons, Jimmy and John, at Orchard and Rockaway Beaches.

Many may also remember James and Peg for their thoughtful gift of a carriage to Thomas and Ellen during their honeymoon in Ireland — a lasting symbol of their love and connection to family.


